

# Welcome from the EUROCON 2007

## General Co-Chairs

On behalf of the International Steering Committee and Local Organizing Committee, we would like to warmly welcome all the EUROCON 2007 participants in Warsaw, Poland. The Conference will be held in the historical Main Building of the Warsaw University of Technology constructed in the first half of 19<sup>th</sup> century, and will focus on promotion of European Electrical, Electronics and Information Technology.

The Conference will start on Sunday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007 with tutorials. Significant developments in our fields of interest will also be highlighted in other Plenary Sessions on Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> September 2007, and on Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> September 2007 with Lectures presented by such excellent experts as Prof. Włodzimierz Koczara (Warsaw University of Technology, Poland) and Prof. Adam Dabrowski (TU Poznan, Poland), respectively

Over 670 abstracts have been submitted in response to the EUROCON 2007 call for papers, and the International Program Committee have selected about 450 out of them for publication. Approximately 2/3 of them will be presented in 34 regular Oral Sessions and the other part will be discussed in 3 Poster Sessions. Additionally, 9 Special Sessions Organized by leading specialist and industry representatives will add to attractiveness of our event.

A student Paper Contest organized traditionally by the IEEE Region 8 Committee will take place on Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> September 2007.

Finally, four tutorials offered by world-known specialists: Rainer Leupers (RWTH Aachen, Germany), Miroslav Skoric (University of Novi Sad, Serbia), Levent Sevgi (Dogus University, Turkey) and Bogdan M. Wilamowski (Auburn University, USA).

The Conference Social Program-including a Welcome Concert in the Saint John Cathedral (Old Town) and a Gala Dinner in the beautiful Main Aula of the Warsaw University of Technology - will guarantee you nice time in Warsaw - city at the centre of the European history.

We are looking forward to welcoming you in Warsaw!
